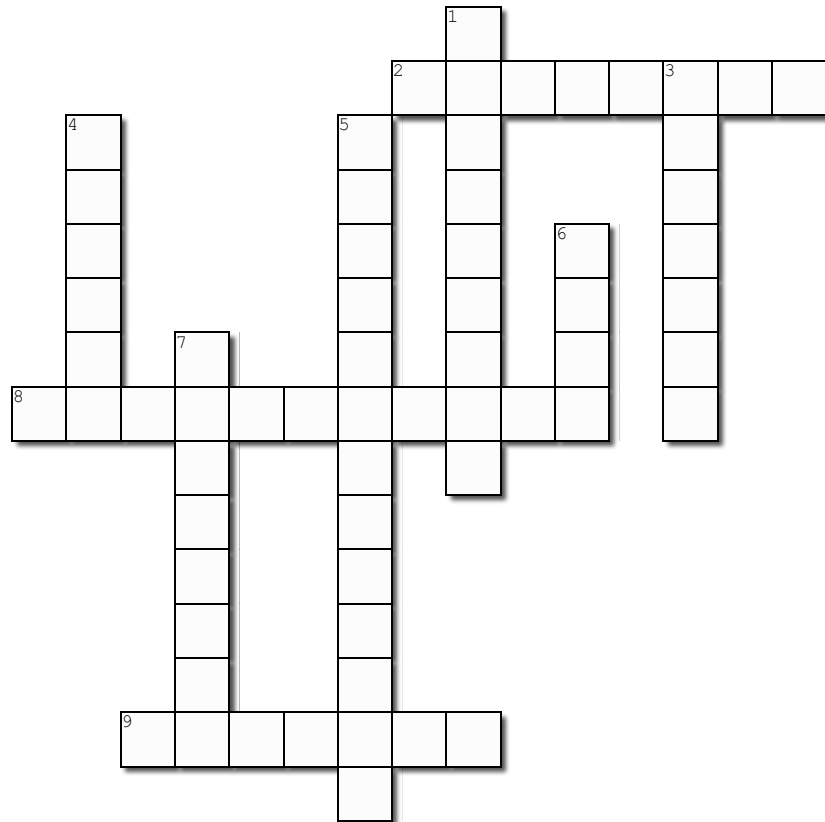

- 2.** A draped female figure used as a column to support an entablature, can be seen in furniture and other decorative arts as well
- 8.** A European style of decoration that reflects Chinese art and/or decorative motifs
- 9.** A series of small carved beads used for edges, rims, and surface decorations in metal, wood, or ceramics

- 1.** An ornament or decoration, usually used on a mantel or cabinet top
- 3.** A male figure acting as a column. Also known as an atlas figure. Male version of the caryatid
- 4.** A square block used as a base, in the display of sculpture, architecture, silver, or ceramics
- 5.** A type of lacquer named for the French brothers Guillaume and Etienne-Simon Martin
- 6.** An S-shaped curve, or a molding with an S-shaped profile, in furniture and architecture
- 7.** In ceramics, glass, silver, or furniture, a matching set
