

# Instructions

1. After printing the template (be sure to print on both sides of the paper), cut out each of the four squares.
2. Fold each square in quarters and cut along the curved lines. Cut off point of the folder paper.
3. Open up the folded papers and cut along the designated lines on the “petals.” (You can discard the pieces of paper that are listed as “discard.”)
4. With the remaining seven pieces or petals, one by one, overlap the cut lines and adhere with glue. Glue the 2 edges of the petal layer together completing a closed petal circle.
5. Use a toothpick or Q-tip to help roll the edges of the petals.
6. If you wish to add a stem to your flower, select a material (we chose a piece of floral stem wire) and place hot glue about 1 inch from the top of the selected material. From largest petal to smallest, slide the petals one by one onto the stem and onto where you have placed the hot glue. To create a rose without a stem, simply glue petal layers together at the base.
