

Ida Caldwell McFaddin's brother Dabney Caldwell suffered through an illness in the 1920s. He and his wife, Edna, sent their two sons Dab and Ted to stay with their Aunt Ida and cousin Mamie for the 1922 Christmas holiday. The boys enjoyed a visit to the Municipal Christmas tree, and the McFaddins even put up a tree in the house for them to enjoy.

"Your letter about the children's Xmas did us both good....
They must have had a most wonderful Xmas, bless their little hearts."

James Lewis Caldwell McFaddin, or Blink as he was affectionately known, came home from Harvard Law School in 1922 to spend Christmas with his family in Beaumont. Ida met him at the train station at the late hour of 3:00am since the train was running 5 hours late.

"...Went to meet Blink...train 5 [hours] late-arrived at 3 AM Ma [met] him."
